

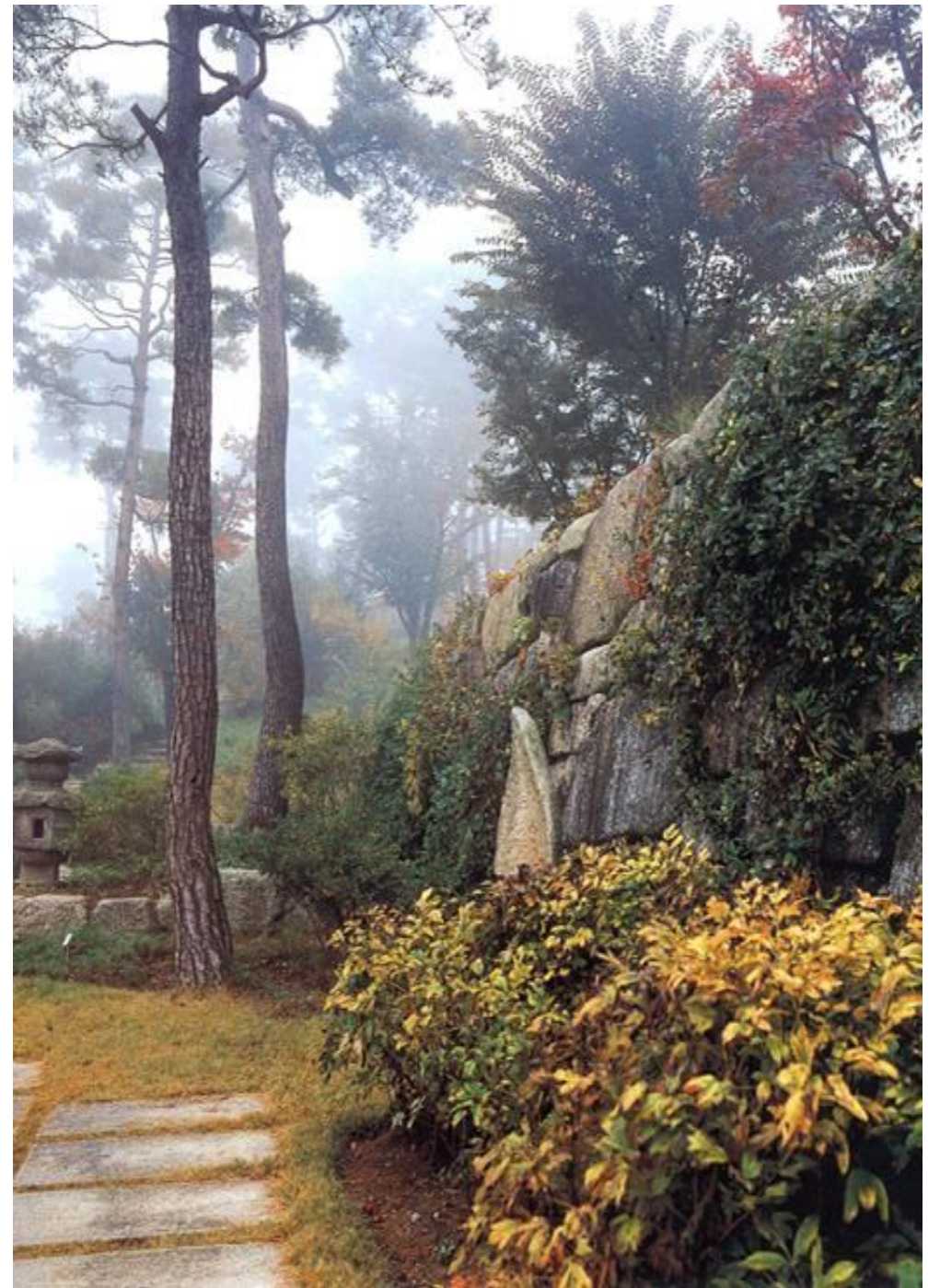

Heewon was created to celebrate Korean traditional aesthetics and culture for the 15th anniversary of Samsung's Hoam Art Museum.

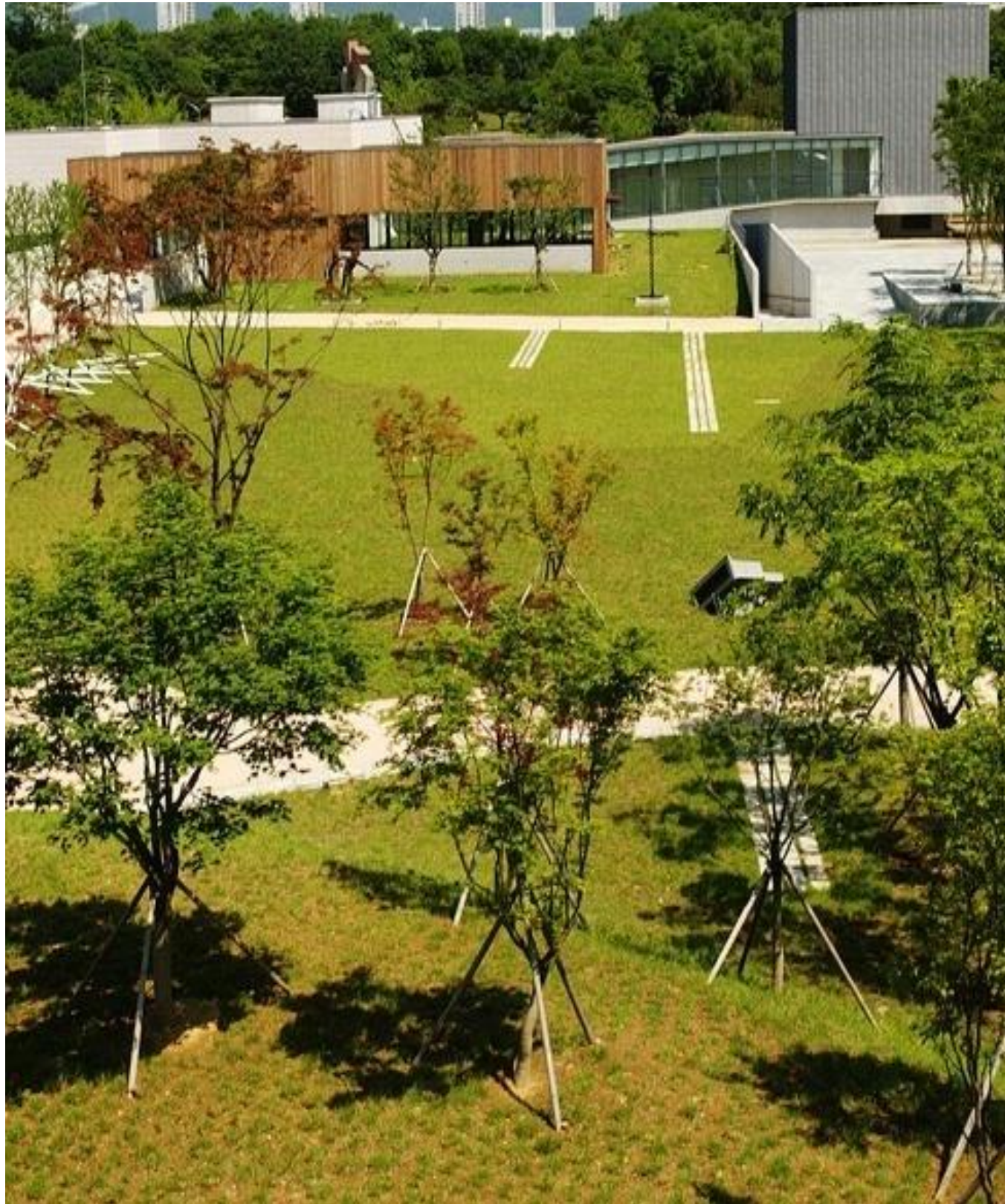

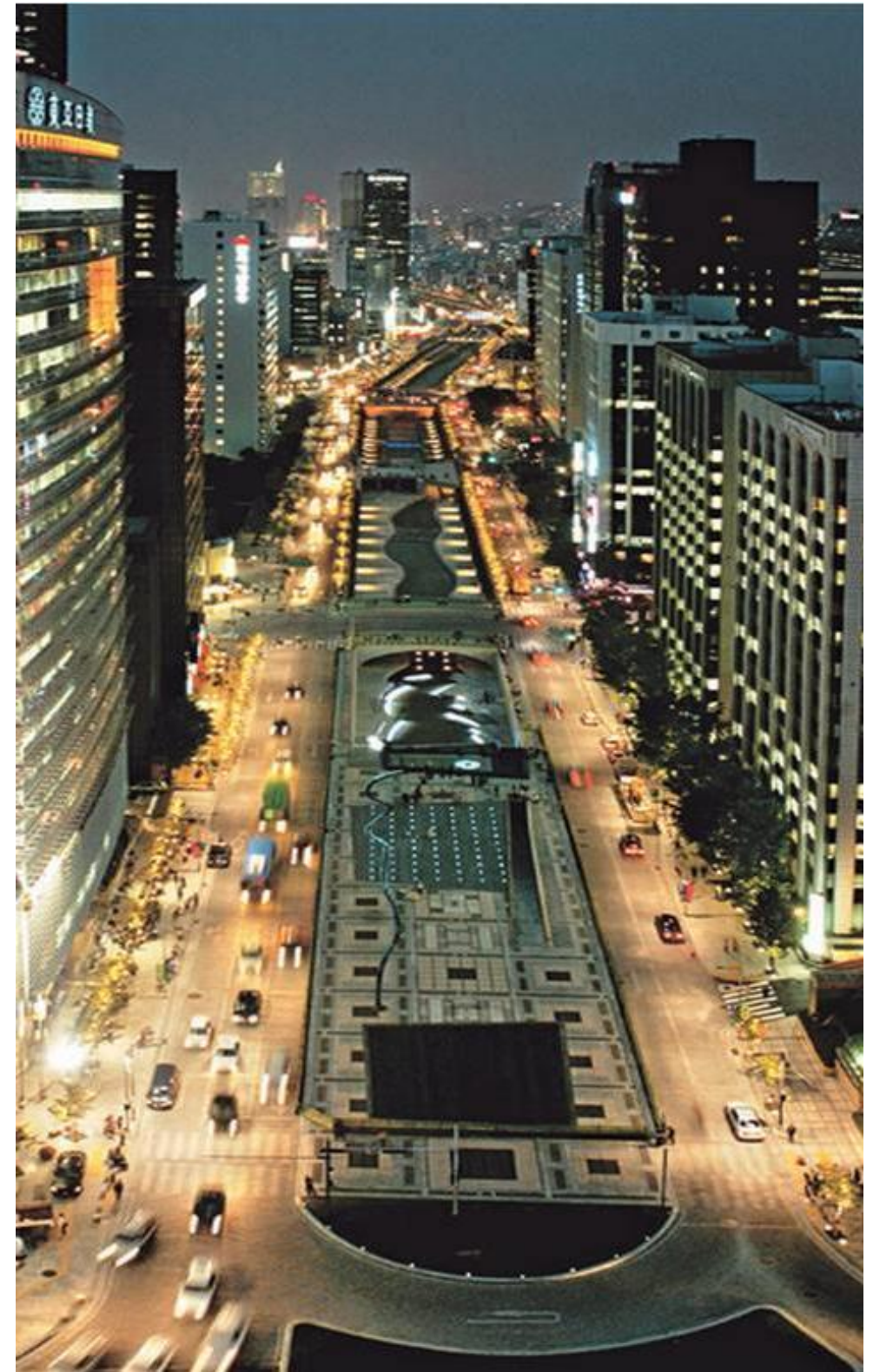

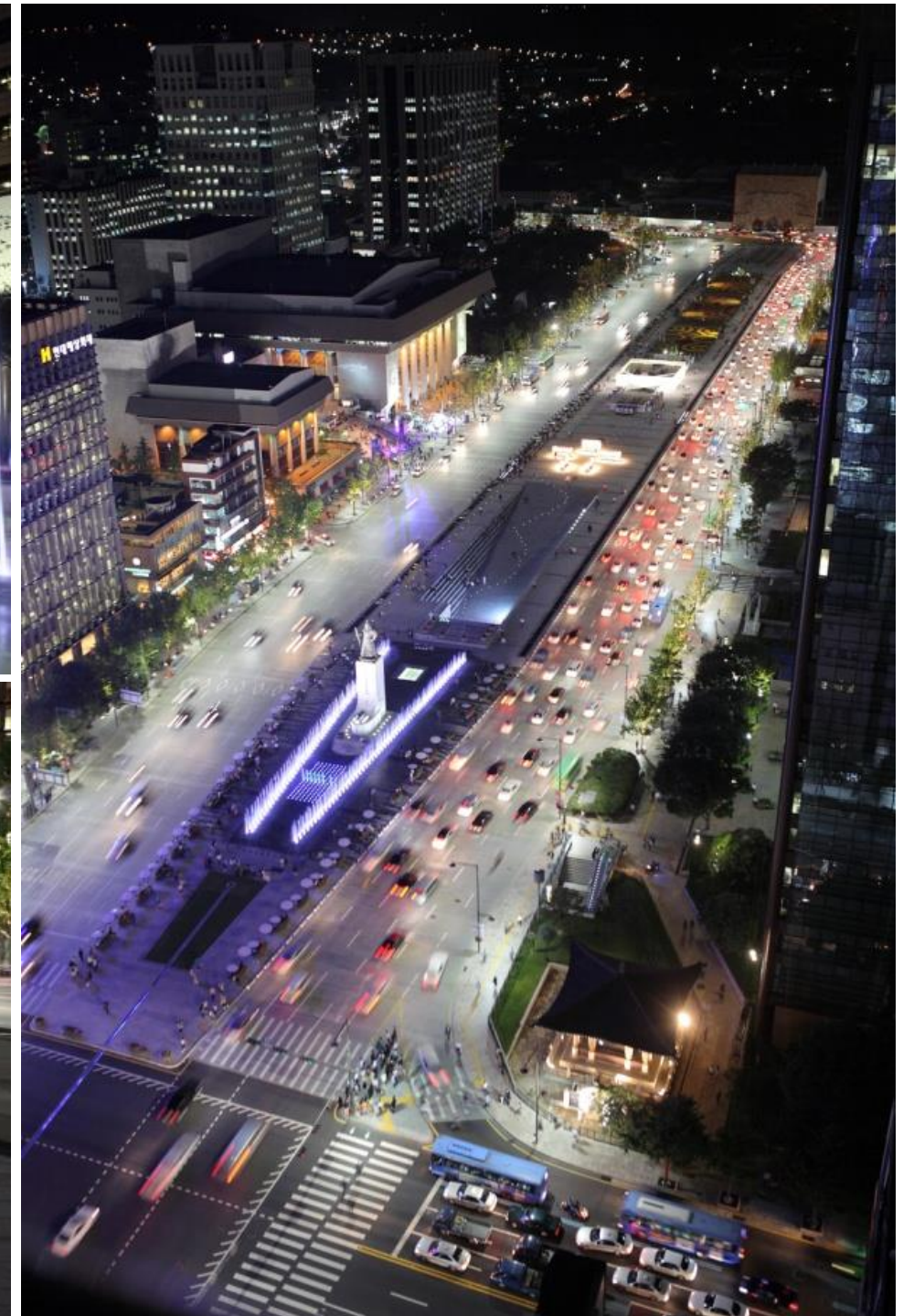


Cheonggye Plaza / Cheonggye Stream Restoration Section 1

Long having been an integral part of commoners' lives in Seoul,

Cheonggye Stream was covered up to host an elevated highway during Korea's economic boom until it went under restoration in 2002.

The newly renovated 5.8km-long stream has become a vital open space where nature meets urban to connect the daily activities of citizens in the heart of Seoul.



Gwanghwamun Plaza

Gwanghwamun Plaza is situated in the symbolic Sejong-ro area and was significant that it converted a car-oriented space into a cultural area for citizens. Recovering the historic axis of Mt. Bukak-Gyeongbok Palace-Gwanghwamun, the plaza incorporates traces of the historic space to create a plaza for national events and also daily cultural events.

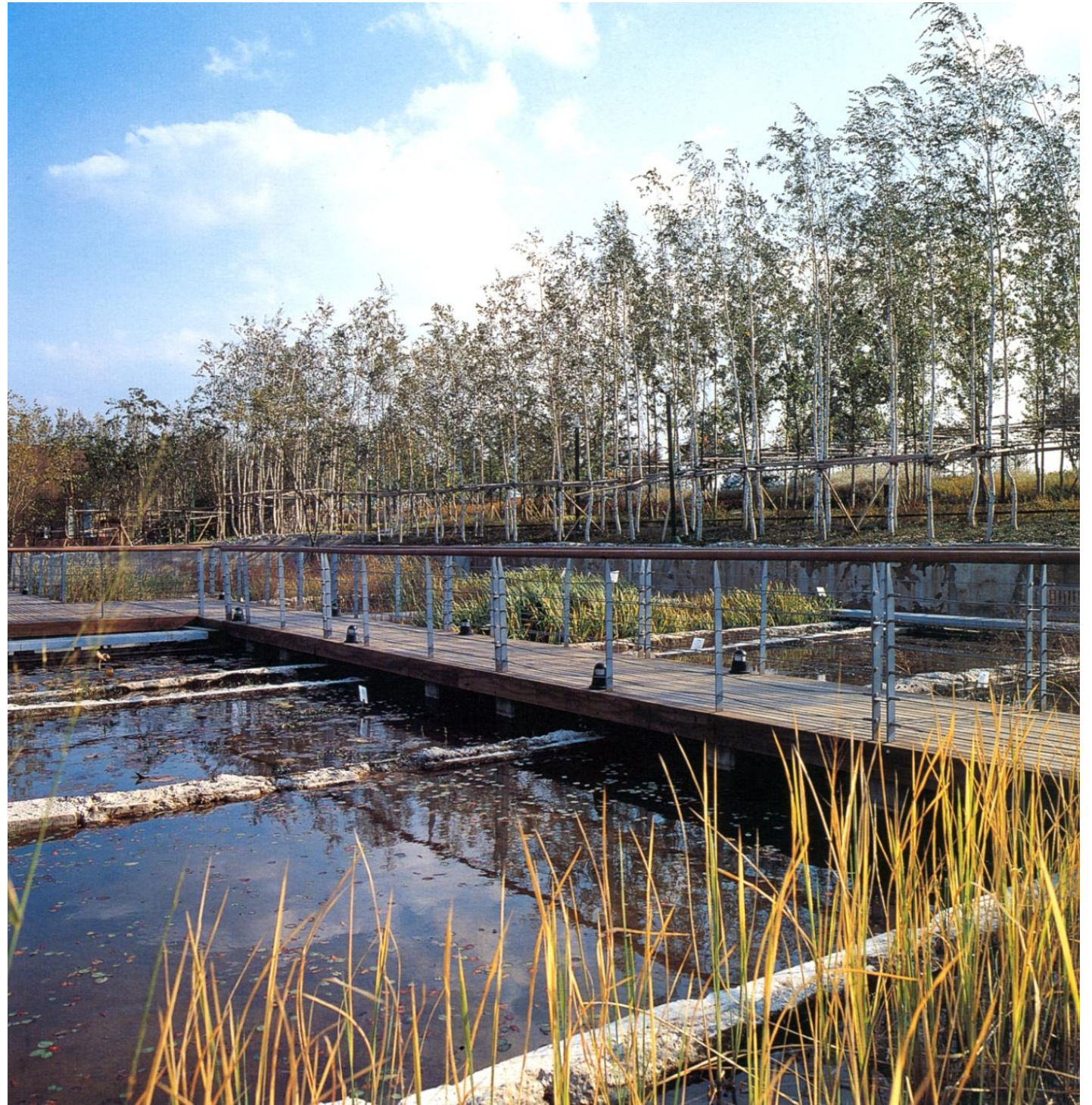
The Seoul Botanic Park is a Botanic Park in the Magok district, which is built during the development of agricultural land in Magok-dong, Gangseo-gu. Through the Seoul Botanical Garden, citizens planned to meet theme gardens, lake parks, open forest parks, and wetland ecology on a level of flattened area from the Han River.
